



YEAR 7 AND 8 SUBJECTS

CURRICULUM STRUCTURE

All students in Years 7 and 8 at Ruyton study the following subjects:

Art
Drama
Mathematics
English
Music
Health Education
Physical Education
Humanities Science

Students in Year 7 also study Digitech.

Elective Subjects

In addition to the Learning Areas above, all students are expected to study one Language, unless advised to join the Tutorial program. **Students elect to study one of the following subjects:**

Chinese
Chinese Advanced (by invitation – from Year 8)
French
French Advanced (by invitation – from Year 8)
Individual Learning (by invitation – Year 7 and 8)

The Language selected at Year 7 will be studied until the completion of Year 9.

FLEX Time

Students in Years 7 and 8 will have a specified number of FLEX periods each timetable cycle (10 days). FLEX periods will be supervised by a teacher and provide students with the opportunity to use this time as they choose to continue learning tasks or revision for any subject they are studying. FLEX periods will enable students to undertake some '*homework*' tasks during the school day and supports them to develop effective independent learning and organisational skills.
