3. Camp and Retreat Fee - per student

Camps and Retreats are a valuable and compulsory school activities, and all students are required to attend. They assist the boys form shared experience and appreciation of others. We ask all families to support this important aspect of their son's personal growth. If your son is unable to attend camp/retreat because of medical reasons it must be supported by a specialist doctor 's certificate. If there are exceptional circumstances, we ask families to contact the relevant Formation leader to discuss how your son might engage in an adjusted way to ensure he does not miss out on this formative experience.

To ensure facilities are available on the date's camps/retreats are planned for, the College books with the external providers of these services and pays in advance (based on current student numbers). The College will not refund camp/retreat fees for non-attendance once numbers have been confirmed.

If the College is not able to run an activity as a result of COVID-19 we will work with the vendor to book an alternate date or secure refunds for families.

The cost of the camp/retreat is a direct reflection of the cost of the vendor. Its variance is based on number of days and types of activities.

Payment Terms and Conditions

The College uses FACTS Management - fee collection system.

All parents and guardians are requested to open an account with FACTS and make payments through that system.

<i>All fees and charges must be paid on or before the following dates:</i>	
1st instalment (1/3 of the total fees and charges invoiced)	28 Feb 2021
2nd instalment (1/3 of the total fees and charges invoiced)	28 May 2021
3rd instalment (1/3 of the total fees and charges invoiced)	28 August 2021

Unpaid Fees

If you elect to pay in 3 instalments and if an instalment is not paid by the due date, an overdue fee of \$100 will be charged.

If you have set-up a payment plan in FACTS and the payment was returned due to insufficient funds or other reasons, FACTS will charge you a return fee of \$33.

Parents who have temporary difficulties in meeting payment dates must contact the College Finance office early (before payment due dates) to discuss and agree on a revised plan.

If the fees are not paid by the due dates and there is no payment plan in place:

- The Principal may suspend or terminate a student's enrolment
- The debt outstanding may be referred to an external debt collection agency
- Legal action may be taken to recover the debt.

Student Leaving

Parents must give one term's notice in writing or by email to the College to withdraw their son from the College. If one term's notice is not received by the College, school fees for one term (1/4 of the year's school fee) will be charged.
