COVID 19 ROADMAP TO RECOVERY ~ Phase 4

Schools are asked to remind our school community of the current requirements to maintain good hygiene practices and physical distancing of adults. Access to hand sanitiser and actively promoting hand hygiene, physical distancing and coughing/sneezing etiquette continues in the classrooms and will help to keep our schools as safe as we can during Phase 4 of the WA Roadmap to Recovery and contribute to the general health and well-being of our children and staff. The Australian Health Protection Principal Committee (AHPPC) continues to note that there is very limited evidence of transmission between children in the school environment, resulting in a relaxing of the physical distancing requirements between students however adults in schools should continue to keep up physical distancing of 1.5 metres where possible.

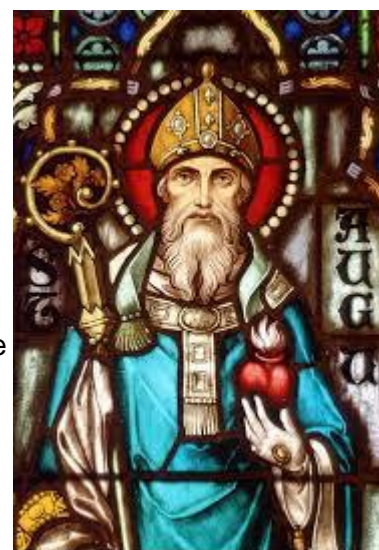
