Cost:

Acceptance into the holiday programme is not confirmed until the total cost of \$255 including GST is paid. The cost is \$255 per player/ technical camp.

There is no refund should you decide to withdraw during the programme. Should there be genuine circumstances surrounding withdrawal, partial refund maybe considered by the Executive Team.

Final registration for the camp closes on **Friday 27 March** – April and **Friday 19 June – July**.

All Fees must be paid at the time of registration. Late enrolments are possible, but training tops cannot be guaranteed.

Should circumstances surrounding international travel become restricted, the programme may be altered or postponed.

Places are limited and will be filled on a first come first served basis. Should you be unable to gain a place fee will be refunded.

Cost includes: all three coaching sessions under with the Tottenham Hotspurs Global Academy coach, Scots College/ Tottenham Hotspur Nike training top, GST.

Venue: Te Whaea Turf, Hutchison Road, Newtown, or alternative grounds should weather field conditions dictate that these grounds are not usable. Please note access by car to the top car park and main entrance is off **Hall** Street (enter Southern Cross Patient Car park) as well as small access road behind Te Whaea dance centre lower car park.

The Programme

This is an individual player Programme whereby the players will gain an opportunity to improve their ball mastery and gain feedback on their individual ball handling skills. Themes for delivery are:

1. **Technical DNA:** players to develop a range of techniques to manipulate the ball. Players will be given a range of 'floor work' and 'aerial' challenges to help them travel in multiple directions using different surfaces and become more dynamic individuals.
2. **1-V-1 Defender in front:** players will practice and develop an understanding of different techniques to manipulate the ball in a 1-v-1 scenario. Understand the strategy behind the 'when' and 'how' to beat an opponent and apply these in practice.
3. **1-V-1 Defender behind:** Identify the key methods of beating an opponent who is behind you. Explore a variety of techniques required when facing away from goal in order to create space to create opportunities to play forward.
4. **Fundamentals & Goalscoring:** Practice a range of different passing and receiving techniques. Explore and practice different finishing techniques to support the development of players goalscoring.

Health, Safety Injury & Medical Conditions Policy:

- Unwell Players -due to the risk of infection, players must be kept at home if they contract or are showing any symptoms of any illness.
- All health and medical conditions that may affect players ability during session must be declared upon registration
- All current Covid restrictions must be adhered to under the current guidelines Ministry of Health and Education.

- Any player medical or behavioural information must be declared upon registration.
