



## Schedule of Tuition Fees and Charges 2026

Tuition Fees are determined annually by the Board of Management in line with the College's Fee Policy which responds to the core purposes of the College: to pass on the teaching, spirituality and values of the Catholic Church, to care for, educate and serve our students, and to nurture the distinctive and special charism of the Sisters of St. Joseph.

Tuition fees are as inclusive as possible covering the majority of activities and events completed throughout the school year. Additional items are listed in the Schedule of Tuition Fees and Charges. Optional activities such as interstate or international trips and some sporting activities also require additional payments.

### Payment of Accounts

Tuition fees are invoiced in full at the start of each year and are due for payment by the end of February. Parents have the option to either pay for the full year in advance or may elect to enter into a payment plan arrangement to pay for the tuition fees in monthly, fortnightly or weekly instalments. Under this arrangement tuition fees are charged in ten equal instalments on the first of the month from February to November inclusive.

### Family Discount

Discounts are available for families if 3 or more children are enrolled at any Catholic school in Tasmania. The discount is determined by the Tasmanian Catholic Education Commission (TCEC) and is consistent across all Catholic schools.

### Financial Assistance

Requests for tuition fee assistance will be considered in accordance with the TCEC School Fees Assistance Policy to assist families with significant financial need who would otherwise be unable to afford to send their children to a Catholic school. Applications for a reduction in fees can be made by families who hold an eligible Concession Card or are experiencing financial hardship.

### Student Withdrawal

As detailed on the Sacred Heart College Enrolment Form, written notice of at least ten school weeks is required prior to withdrawal of a student from the school. Where notice is not provided, ten weeks of tuition fees may need to be paid.

## ADDITIONAL ITEMS:

### Stationery and Booklists

Students from Kindergarten to Year 10 are required to provide their own stationery.

### Sporting Registrations

Registration fees for some sporting activities are payable directly to the College Office. Details relevant to each sport will be provided throughout the year and payment is required before registration for a student is complete.

### Year 9 & 10 - Outdoor Education Levy

This is an elective subject available to Year 9 and Year 10 students. A non-refundable levy of \$300 per annum is payable to contribute towards the cost of the programme and is payable in Term 1.

### Year 9 - Adventure & Enrichment Week Levy

As part of the Year 9 Curriculum, students in Year 9 participate in an Adventure and Enrichment Week at the end of the year. Students may select from a range of camps and day trips in locations around Tasmania. A non-refundable levy of \$250 is payable to contribute towards the cost of the programme and is payable in Term 1.

### The Duke of Edinburgh's International Award

This is an extracurricular activity available to secondary students. A non-refundable levy of approx. \$100 per student is payable to contribute towards the cost of the programme and is payable in Term 1.

### Loaned Items / College Property

Students are expected to respect and to care for all College property and are responsible for any repair or replacement costs incurred as a consequence of wilful damage, neglect or loss of College property. This extends to items loaned to students through the College Library including loaned netbook computers, library books and text books.

### Bring Your Own Laptop

Students from Year 5 to Year 10 require their own laptop computer as part of the College's Bring Your Own Laptop Programme (BYOL). Information on laptop specifications is provided with booklists and can be found on the College website. Students in Kinder to Year 3 utilise class sets of College owned iPads and Year 4 students have access to College laptops.

### Year 6 - Canberra Trip \*

Year 6 students have the opportunity to visit Canberra to complement the work they have completed throughout the year on Australian History and Democratic Government. Cost in 2025 - \$1300 per student. A non-refundable deposit is payable in April with the balance payable in early September.

### Year 9 & 10 - Japan Study Tour \*

An extension trip to Japan is offered every second year to students studying Japanese in Years 9 and 10. 2026 trip cost – approx. \$5,500.

### Year 9 & 10 – Timor-Leste Immersion \*

In past years students from Years 9 and 10 have had the opportunity to visit Timor-Leste for an immersion experience, designed to provide students with opportunities to develop understanding of principles of social justice, and awareness of other cultures - approx. \$5,500 - \$6,500.

#### \* Please Note:

- The price of these trips vary depending upon the number of students involved.
- Payment of full tuition fees is required before consideration is given to attending these optional trips.

### Insurance / Personal Property

It is a requirement that valuable items are not left in student lockers or classrooms overnight. The College is not liable for the loss or damage of any student owned equipment, valuables or property brought onto College grounds.

The College encourages parents to insure all student owned netbooks/computer devices under their home and contents insurance policy or take out a personal effects policy for the device.
