FREQUENTLY ASKED QUESTIONS

Where is the Art Show held? How do I get there and where can I park?

The Art Show is held in the Granowski Auditorium at St Hilda's School, Southport. Entry is via Gate 7 on Cougal Street. Parking is available on school grounds or in surrounding streets.

Is the Art Show wheelchair accessible?

Yes, the Granowski Auditorium is wheelchair accessible.

Can I take photos of the artworks?

We kindly ask that no photographs be taken of the artworks. All pieces are available to view in our online gallery, and our friendly staff are happy to help you locate any works you love.

I'm an artist and have a buyer who wants to purchase a piece early – is this allowed?

Unfortunately, no. Sales begin during Opening Night on Friday, 1 August 2025 at 5:00pm. Artworks will be viewable online from Friday 18 July.

Artist payments will be processed within 5 business days following the close of the Festival.
