To ensure all items are suitable for resale or donation, we kindly ask that the following guidelines are followed prior to submitting any pieces.

Items Accepted for Consignment

(From the current uniform supplier and in very good condition and **laundered**)

- Senior Tunic
- Junior Dress
- Polycotton Jumper
- Polycotton Cardigan
- Blazer (dry-cleaned) A \$30 dry-cleaning fee to be taken off monies paid if not dry-cleaned.
- Backpacks
- Sports shorts Eg. Touch, Basketball, AFL
- Sports shirts (Junior, Senior and house) Eg. Touch, Basketball, Volleyball, Soccer
- Tracksuit Jacket
- Tracksuit Pants

Items Accepted as Donations

- Hats - caps, visors and bucket
- Scarves
- Wool jumper
- Wool cardigans

Items Not Accepted for Consignment or Donation

To maintain quality and hygiene standards, we are unable to accept:

- Swimmers
- White blouses
- Rowing Zoot suits
- Gymnastics suits
- Stained or soiled clothing

Condition Requirements

Before items are submitted, please ensure they are:

- Freshly laundered
- Free from stains, marks and odours
- In good repair with all buttons, zips and press studs intact

We are more than happy to take any clothing that isn't in a sellable condition, as we proudly work with organisations that will recycle these items.

Items that do not meet these standards may not be processed.
