Years 4-6 Vocal Ensemble	Mondays 1-1.30pm	Commencing Monday, 9 February	For Years 4, 5 & 6 Choir Members – By Audition.
Junior String Ensemble (Years 3-6)	Wednesdays 7.30-8.15am	Commencing Wednesday 4 February	For all Years 3-6 with string instrument skills and a minimum of 12 months experience.
Junior Concert Band (Years 4-6)	Tuesdays 7.15-8.15am	Commencing Tuesday 3 February	For all Year 6 with wind/percussion instrument skills and a minimum of 12 months experience. Lower grades by audition only.
