Novel Coronavirus - 2019-nCov

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The College has been monitoring the situation regarding Novel Coronavirus over the last two weeks. This includes advice from Queensland Health.

A link is provided below to current information from Queensland Health. This advice includes that if children become sick (e.g. fever, flu-like symptoms, sore throat, headaches, breathing difficulties) after having recently had links to Wuhan or the Province of Hubei within China, or in contact with someone who is a confirmed case, they should present immediately to a doctor and not attend school while unwell.

In terms of Boarding, the College has been in contact with our overseas students who are returning from China in the coming days. These boys will be assessed and monitored by our Health Centre staff. Subject to this assessment these students will be returning to class and regular school life.

As the welfare of all students and staff continues to be the College's priority, it is a timely reminder to follow basic hygiene practice.

The College will continue to monitor the situation and will take advice from Queensland Health.

We thank you for your support and we look forward to a smooth commencement to the start of the school year.
