UPDATE - Novel Coronavirus - 2019-nCov

Dear Parents and Caregivers,

The College continues to monitor the developing situation with regards to the Coronavirus and we wish to update you further with some specific information.

We have six students who reside in China and we have been in regular communication with their families to ensure they are safe and well. The College has been informed of all their travel movements within China since 29 November, (the end of the 2019 school year).

Five of these students are current boarders. Two of these boarders, who have visited Hubei Province, remain in China and we are working with their families about their return to Australia. Subsequent to this return to Australia, they will be in the care of family and after 14 days will return to the College, subject to a medical clearance. This is in line with Queensland Health advice.

The College is also following Queensland Health advice in respect to the four students who are currently returning to school. They have not visited Wuhan or the Hubei Province. These students have been assessed and will continue to be monitored by our Health Centre staff on a daily basis. Subject to this assessment these students are returning to class and regular school life tomorrow.

Further to this, if your son has travelled to Wuhan or the Hubei Province during the holidays, he is not to return to school without medical clearance, as per Queensland Health advice. The College will continue to monitor this situation with Queensland Health as the welfare of all students and staff continues to be the College's priority.
