Dear Parents and Caregivers,

Many of you will be aware that today Queensland Health identified three positive cases of COVID-19 among residents who reside in the Logan City and surrounding southern suburbs of Brisbane.

Thankfully, I am not aware of any direct links between the cases and our College.

However, as a result of the new cases, I have been advised that the Queensland Government has announced that:

1. A Christian College in Logan has been closed for 48 hours for deep cleaning
2. A small number of shopping centres in the Logan area have been closed for 48 hours for deep cleaning
3. A church in the Logan area has been closed for 48 hours for deep cleaning
4. All Aged Care facilities in the Metropolitan South Region have been closed to all visitors as a precaution.

I have been in contact with relevant authorities to seek clarification on the impact to staff and families of St Laurence's College. At this stage, I have not been advised of any new directions or restrictions which would impact on the current operation of our College. As always, if you or a family member have flu-like symptoms, please seek immediate medical advice. These students should remain at home until cleared to return to the College by a medical practitioner.

It is possible that this position may change. I will of course provide you with updated advice as soon as I am able to.

Please keep all people impacted by COVID-19 and those working to assist us to manage this pandemic in your prayers.
