Uniform Policy (Student)

Introduction

Wearing of the College uniform is an essential condition of enrolment at St. Michael's College. St. Michael's College maintains very high standards of presentation for its students. St. Michael's College uniform creates a sense of identity for students, promotes mutual respect and creates an atmosphere of uniformity, pride, loyalty and equity.

Students should wear their uniform proudly and well, realising that at all times they are ambassadors for the College.

Scope

All students must comply with this policy.

Policy

STUDENT HAIR

All guidelines relating to hair must be followed. Students failing to adhere to this policy may be unable to attend St. Michael's College until compliance with this policy is achieved. Principal's discretion is able to be applied in individual circumstances.

GENERAL

- Students' hair must be clean, worn neatly and combed off the face
- Extremes of style and colour are NOT PERMITTED (hair colour should be the student's natural colour)
- No hair colouring of any description is allowed at St. Michael's College (unless exceptions are applied for special events)
- Short cuts are to be no shorter than a number 2 (#2) blade - no patterns/tracks/shaved lines.

HAIR - GIRLS

- Girls hair that is longer than the top of the collar line is to be fully and neatly tied back
- Only basic maroon hair ties may be worn
- Coloured hair accessories may be worn at College sporting events.

HAIR - BOYS

- Boys hair is to be no longer than the collar and the lobe of the ears
- The fringe is to be no longer than the eyebrows when dropped vertically down to the front
- Coloured hair accessories may be worn at College sporting events.

STUDENT JEWELLERY

All guidelines relating to jewellery must be followed. Student failing to adhere to this policy will be asked to remove the item of jewellery and may be unable to attend the College until compliance with this policy is achieved. Principal's discretion is able to be applied in individual circumstances.

WATCHES

Boys and girls may wear a simple watch. The wearing of expensive watches is discouraged.

NECK CHAINS

Boys and girls may wear a simple chain with a cross, religious or cultural symbol.

EARRINGS

Girls only may wear plain, gold/silver studs or sleepers (one earring per earlobe).

MEDICAL JEWELLERY

Any jewellery required for a medical purpose is exempt from this policy.



STUDENT UNIFORM

All guidelines relating to student uniform must be followed. Students failing to adhere to this policy may be unable to attend St. Michael's College until compliance with this policy is achieved. Principal's discretion is able to be applied in individual circumstances.

All uniform requirements are purchased through the College Uniform Shop (excluding shoes)

PREP BOYS AND GIRLS UNIFORM

Shirt:	House coloured prep polo (red, yellow, green)
Shorts:	Royal blue with St. Michael's College logo
Hat:	Reversible bucket hat (with St. Michael's College logo)
Socks:	Sport socks (ankle length - white/maroon SMC)
Shoes:	Plain black joggers with velcro
Winter:	Maroon sports jacket (with St. Michael's College logo) and track pants

YEAR 1 - 4 BOYS FORMAL UNIFORM

Shirt:	Maroon/white check shirt (with St. Michael's College logo)
Shorts:	Grey shorts (belt loop/elastic back)
Hat:	Maroon hat (with St. Michael's College logo)
Socks:	Formal grey socks with maroon stripes
Shoes:	Plain black, leather, polished lace-up shoes
Winter:	Maroon knit with blue stripe on neck and cuff (with St. Michael's College logo) or maroon microfibre jacket (with St. Michael's College logo) and maroon pants

YEAR 5 - 6 BOYS FORMAL UNIFORM

Shirt:	Blue senior shirt (with St. Michael's College logo)
Tie:	Maroon senior boys tie (with St. Michael's College logo)
Shorts:	Grey shorts (belt loop)
Belt:	Black leather
Hat:	Maroon hat (with St. Michael's College logo)
Socks:	Formal grey socks with maroon stripes
Shoes:	Plain black, leather, polished lace-up shoes
Winter:	Maroon knit with blue stripe on neck and cuff (with St. Michael's College logo) or maroon microfibre jacket (with St. Michael's College logo) and maroon pants

YEAR 1 - 4 GIRLS FORMAL UNIFORM

Dress:	Maroon/white check dress (maroon bummers/bike pants)
Blouse:	Maroon/white check blouse (with St. Michael's College logo)
Tie:	Maroon girls tie
Skort:	Maroon skort
Hat:	Maroon hat (with St. Michael's College logo)
Socks:	Formal white socks with maroon stripes
Shoes:	Plain black, leather, polished lace-up shoes
Tights:	Beige, worn without socks (only during winter)
Winter:	Maroon knit with blue stripe on neck and cuff (with St. Michael's College logo) or maroon microfibre jacket (with St. Michael's College logo) and maroon pants



YEAR 5 - 6 GIRLS FORMAL UNIFORM

Blouse:	Blue senior blouse (with St. Michael's College logo)
Tie:	Maroon girls tie
Skirt:	Maroon senior skirt
Skort:	Maroon skort
Hat:	Maroon hat (with St. Michael's College logo)
Socks:	Formal white socks with maroon stripes
Shoes:	Plain black, leather, polished lace-up shoes
Tights:	Beige, worn without socks (only during winter)
Winter:	Maroon knit with blue stripe on neck and cuff (with St. Michael's College logo) or maroon microfibre jacket (with St. Michael's College logo) and maroon pants

YEAR 1 - 6 BOYS AND GIRLS SPORT UNIFORM

Shirt:	Sports polo poly (maroon with red, yellow or green side panel)
Shorts:	Royal blue with St. Michael's College logo
Hat:	Reversible bucket hat (with St. Michael's College logo) or maroon hat (with St. Michael's College logo)
Socks:	Sport socks (ankle length - white/maroon SMC)
Shoes:	Plain black, leather, polished lace-up joggers
Winter:	Maroon knit with blue stripe on neck and cuff (with St. Michael's College logo) or maroon microfibre jacket (with St. Michael's College logo) and maroon pants

OTHER UNIFORM REQUIREMENTS

All guidelines relating to other uniform requirements must be followed. Students failing to comply may be unable to attend St. Michael's College until compliance with this policy is achieved. Principal's discretion is able to be applied in individual circumstances.

COLLEGE BACKPACK

All students are to use the maroon College backpack while attending the College.

COLLEGE LIBRARY/HOMEWORK BAGS

All students are to use the maroon College library bags and the blue College homework bags while attending the College.

EXCURSIONS/CAMPS

The appropriate uniform attire for excursions/camps will be outlined in the excursion/camp permission letter.

HATS

Students are to wear College hats when outside – No hat no play in the sun.

LABELLING ITEMS

All uniform items and valuables brought to the College must be marked clearly with the student's name.

MAKE UP

Students are not to wear any make up to the College.

NAIL POLISH

Students are not to wear any nail polish to the College.

PLAIN CLOTHES DAY (FREE DRESS)

Outfits must be sleeved and sun safe with no bare midriff or inappropriate slogans. College hats are required and shoes must be closed in.

SHOES



Prep - plain black, leather joggers with velcro

Formal (Year 1 – 6) – plain black, low-heeled, polished leather, lace up shoes

Sports (Year 1 – 6) - plain black, polished leather joggers

(boat/deck shoes with side laces, Mary Jane, skateboard-type shoes are not allowed)

SWIM WEAR

Students are to wear plain black swimwear

Boys – black long leg trunks (no board shorts)

Girls – black one-piece swim suit

Swimming caps are supplied by the College.

SUNGLASSES

The wearing of sunglasses when outside is optional. Students who elect to wear sunglasses should ensure that their glasses comply with AS 1067. Neutral colours such as black or brown only. Sunglasses that attract excessive attention are not acceptable. Students wearing sunglasses should remove them when talking with other students or staff.

UNIFORM TIDINESS

Boys shirts are to be tucked in and socks pulled up

Ties must be correctly worn

Uniforms must be in good condition, clean and free from stains.

Responsibilities

College Responsibilities

St. Michael's College acknowledges its responsibility to:

- Provide this policy to parents/caregivers when they enrol their child/ren
- Ensure this policy is to be available via an orientation pack and on the College website
- Ensure staff will check uniforms daily to make sure students are wearing the correct uniform and in the correct manner.

Parent/Caregivers Responsibilities

At St. Michael's College, parents/caregivers have a responsibility to:

- Provide and maintain the correct uniform and general appearance for their child/children
- Ensure their child/ren are appropriately dressed each school day
- Contact/inform the College should the correct uniform not be available for any reason.

Student Responsibilities

At St. Michael's College, students have a responsibility to:

- Wear the full uniform as outlined in the policy each day
- Keep their uniform neat and clean.
