Description of Our Boarding Facilities

St Philip's College provides accommodation for up to 60 boarders. The facilities are co-educational, with girls and boys accommodated in separate boarding houses but sharing common facilities such as the dining room, the recreation room and recreational facilities on the College grounds.

There are two boarding houses and a medical centre located at the College, all positioned at the rear of the main school buildings and facing onto a pleasant, landscaped courtyard. The boarding houses back onto the Old Telegraph Station National Park providing a private, quiet and very scenic setting.

The boys live in McKechnie House. Students share twin rooms on these floors, as well as two spacious common rooms and a balcony or outdoor area. A supervising member of staff has a self-contained flat on each floor.

The girls live in Heaslip House, which offers twin and single room accommodation for the students, as well as separate staff flats for members of staff. The Director of Boarding lives in a residence at the back of Heaslip House. Junior and senior common rooms are located at opposite ends of this building and all the girls have access to computer facilities.
