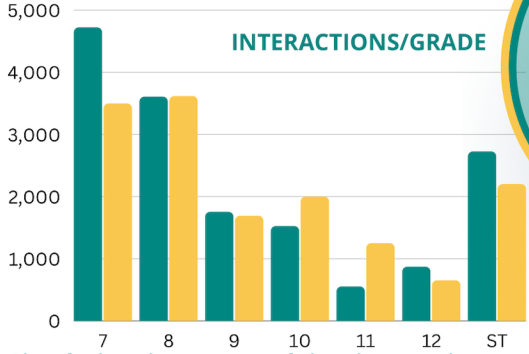

Doesn't include research help, reader advisory, behaviour management or technical help.

2022 is our second strongest year on record. Grades 7, 8, 9 & 12 consolidated service level gains made last year while grades 10 & 11 showed record growth. Class bookings in the Library increased, but there were less research classes, shown by a lower InHouse count. We will work with teaching staff & curriculum leaders to strengthen use of the Library even more in 2023.
