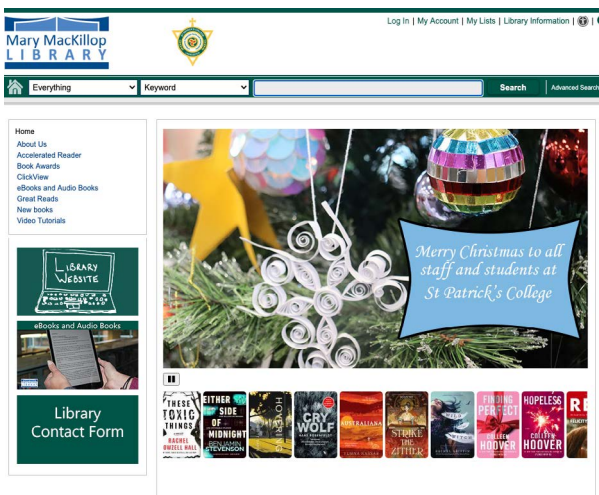


# SAINT MARY MACKILLOP LIBRARY at CROAGH PATRICK

The key to your online Library is via the Library catalogue, the Library website and our eBooks and audiobooks.



## THE LIBRARY CATALOGUE

All of the Library's collections can be searched via the Library catalogue at:

### The catalogue will help you find:

Books to read, or help with research, A list of **"Great Reads"** where you can find your next book,

If the book you want to read is already out - Place it on hold to make sure you get a notice to pick it up the minute it is returned,

Manage your St Mary MacKillop Library account online.

### There are extra features on our catalogue:

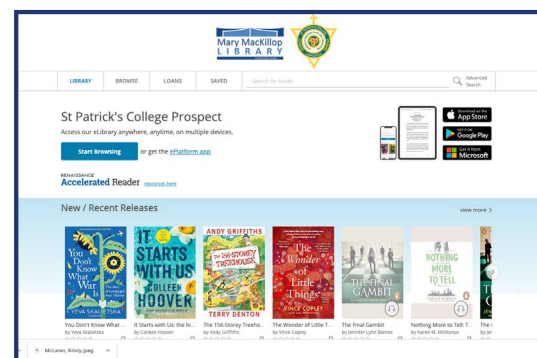
- "Walk" along the shelves using our virtual shelf-browser widget;

The Library has a large range of eBooks on the **Wheeler's ePlatform**. Download one of the titles from the catalogue now.

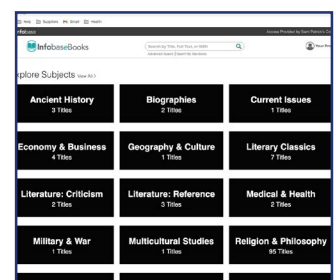
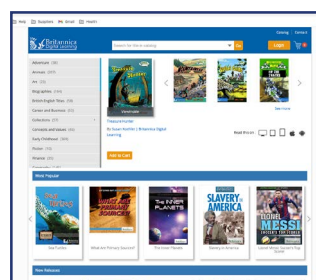
The bonus of using an ePlatform resource is that these items are returned to the Library automatically after 2-3 weeks.

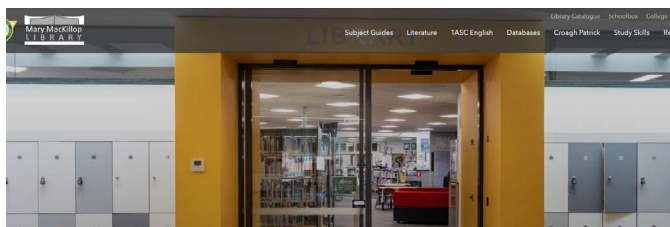


You can also access the following non-fiction eBooks from the Library website.

## LIBRARY WEBSITE

This site helps you with many of your homework and research requirements.

### Databases

These are great online resources that will extend the material you find in textbooks and the books on the Library shelves. Remember you will need your username and password to log on.

This is where you will find:

- **World Book Online** – Gives you access to thousands of articles, videos and audio clips, and images ready to be used in your assignments.
- **Cloudsource Open Access & Cloudsource +** – Opor flagship database offering 50 million + high quality research articles, as well as combining EBSCO premium databases in a powerful federated search.
- **EBSCO ANZ Reference** - Designed for libraries in Australia, this resource provides the largest collection of full text from leading regional and international periodicals, full-text reference books, full-text biographies and a collection of images containing more than one million photos, maps and flags.



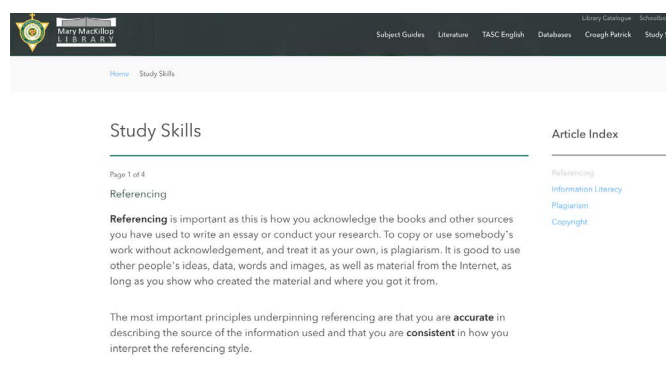
- **Science Online** – Includes articles, videos and animations, experiments, the latest science news and biographies of leading scientists from around the world.

The bonus when using any one of these databases, is that they will help you with any referencing requirements, providing a reference in the style you want ready to copy and paste into your reference list.

### Referencing

Referencing the material you use in your assignments – from books, online magazines, the Library's databases and the internet is very important. You do not want to be accused of plagiarism. You can easily avoid this by creating reference lists for the work you submit to your teachers. At Croagh Patrick **Harvard** is the referencing system your teachers would like you to use.

If you would like some extra help in this area, go to the Library Website and look under **"Study Skills"**. This is where you will find information on plagiarism and referencing. You can also read or print-out the **Harvard referencing guide**.
