What is Student Assistance (STAS)?	Student Assistance provides assistance for eligible families towards the cost of school resources. STAS is provided through College resourcing rather than payment direct to families. In 2021 The Student Assistance Scheme was changed and broadened to provide assistance to more families. If you are a current concession card holder (Centrelink Health Care Card, Low Income Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession card or a Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card) you can apply using this form.
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How to apply for STAS

Step 1	Complete personal details of you and your partner, if you have one. (See Page 3)
Step 2	Complete details for all your dependent children
Step 3	Attach a copy of current concession card (Centrelink Health Care Card, Low Income Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession card or a Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card) or tick the box indicating that you have already provided a copy to the school with your Concession Card Discount Form.
Step 4	Read and sign the 'Declaration and Authorisation' section on the back of the Application Form. (See Page 4)
Step 5	Lodge the completed form and required information at the College or scan and email to fees@stpatricks.tas.edu.au

If I am an independent student, how do I apply?	If you are already recorded by the college as an independent student, simply email fees@stpatricks.tas.edu.au and advise that you wish to be added to the STAS scheme.
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How do I know if I am eligible to apply?	If you hold a current concession card that is subject to an income test (e.g. Centrelink Health Care Card, Low Income Health Care Card, Pensioner Concession card or a Department of Veterans' Affairs Pensioner Concession Card) you are eligible to apply for STAS. Grandparents raising children are also eligible to apply for and receive STAS.
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How will I know if my application is successful or not?	<ul style="list-style-type: none">You will receive written advice of the outcome of your application.
