Excellence in Music

Scholarships may be offered to students who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or Permanent Residents. Please note that temporary visa holders (eg 188 visa, 482 visa, 500 visa etc) are not eligible to apply.

Scholarships apply to tuition fees but do not apply to levies or other costs e.g. uniforms. Please note that St Peters Lutheran College does not offer 100% scholarships.

A scholarship awarded by St Peters Lutheran College forms a confidential arrangement between the College and the family and must not be discussed with other parties. Failure to do so may see the scholarship revoked.

It should be noted that if the student was to transfer to another Brisbane high school before the end of Year 12, parents will be required to repay the scholarship percentage received from commencement to conclusion of the student's enrolment.

Excellence in Music Scholarships are offered to exceptional young performers who possess a strong desire to improve and perform music to the highest level. St Peters offers a supportive environment with a wealth of performance opportunities to ensure music students are constantly challenged, actively engaged and well-informed musicians.

The College has discretionary power to determine in which musical areas, and to which students in those areas, it has the capacity to offer assistance and support.

Application Requirements

Year 7 Minimum entry criteria:

Strings:	AMEB Grade 6 or equivalent
Woodwind:	AMEB Grade 4 or equivalent
Brass & Percussion:	AMEB Grade 4 or equivalent
Voice:	AMEB Grade 2 or equivalent
Piano:	AMEB Grade 7 or equivalent

It is requirement that all Excellence in Music Scholarship applicants should submit the following documents:

- Copy of their most recent AMEB Practical Exam result sheet
- Copy of their most recent AMEB Theory/Musicianship Certificate
- Comment sheets/marks from External Eisteddfods or Competitions
- Online link to their performance video consisting of two contrasting pieces on their main instrument.*

*If auditioning on two instruments, then one piece on each will suffice.

NOTE: Current St Peters students are not required to submit a performance video with their application if the relevant Head of Department is fully aware of their performance level.

Application Shortlisting Process (Live Auditions)

Applications and performance videos will be viewed and shortlisted based on the above criteria. Applicants that demonstrate a very high-performance standard will be invited to a live audition.

Live Auditions require the applicant to perform two contrasting pieces and attend an interview (parents included) with the Co-Directors of Music. St Peters currently provides a piano accompanist free of charge for the live audition process which is scheduled for 30 mins in total.

Documentation Required:

Candidates will be required to provide, in PDF format, scanned and emailed;

- a completed online Application for Admission (if not previously submitted or a current student already at the College) and payment of the application processing fee (if not previously paid); and
- a completed Excellence in Music Scholarship application form; and
- detailed records of student involvement and achievement in areas of co-curricular areas of excellence; and
- references including names and contact details of at least two relevant and qualified tutors or teachers, citing the applicants' diligence, application, specific abilities and standards achieved in musical excellence. Note references should not be from a class teacher or relative.
- other information, as detailed above.

Applications and supporting documents including online performance links must be received by the Admissions team admissions@stpeters.qld.edu.au by Wednesday 4 February 2026.
