Academic Scholarship

Guidelines

As a Lutheran school providing quality Christian co-education, St Peters is committed to recognising students' gifts and abilities. In acknowledging God's blessings to us, St Peters offers a number of scholarships to existing and prospective students.

Scholarships may be offered to students who are Australian citizens, New Zealand citizens or Permanent Residents. Please note that temporary visa holders (eg 188 visa, 482 visa, 500 visa etc) are not eligible to apply.

In addition to their scholarship requirements, all students at St Peters are expected to actively participate in a minimum of two (2) co-curricular activities offered within the College.

Scholarships apply to tuition fees but do not apply to levies or other costs e.g. uniforms. Please note that St Peters Lutheran College does not offer 100% scholarships.

A scholarship awarded by St Peters Lutheran College forms a confidential arrangement between the College and the family and must not be discussed with other parties. Failure to do so may see the scholarship revoked.

It should be noted that if the student was to transfer to another Brisbane high school before the end of Year 12, parents will be required to repay the scholarship percentage received from commencement to conclusion of the student's enrolment.

Academic Scholarship

Academic Scholarships are available to new and existing students commencing **Year 7 or Year 10 at St Peters Lutheran College Indooroopilly in 2027**. The Scholarship will be awarded based on the results of the scholarship examination. The Academic Scholarship exam will be held following commencement of Term 1, the year prior to entry.

Availability: Scholarships are available free of means testing and are awarded based on results of the academic scholarship exam.

Awards: The awarding of a scholarship and financial subsidy of each scholarship shall be determined by the Head of College or delegate and the Scholarship Testing Committee.

Tenure: For students applying for an Academic Scholarships for Year 7 the tenure of the Scholarship is for Years 7 – 9. Following a successful review of the Scholarship at the conclusion of Year 9 an application for continuation of the Scholarship will be considered. For students applying for Year 10 the tenure of the Scholarship is for Years 10 – 12.

Scholarships will be reviewed each semester and are subject to continued excellence in academic performance and adherence to the College policies and procedures. Recipients will be required to meet a grade point average each semester and to participate in the schools cocurricular program offered by the College.

Testing: Testing is conducted by an independent organisation appointed by the Head of College.

Fees: The entry fee for candidates taking the examination is listed on the testing organisation's registration form. There is no refund for scholarship candidates who absent themselves from the examination.

Requirement: A completed online [Application for Admission](#) (if not previously submitted) and payment of the application processing fee (if not previously paid).

Registration: Candidates must [register online](#) through the College website.

Opening date: October 2025

Closing date: Registrations for the scholarship exam will close at **9am on Wednesday 4 February 2026.**

Exam: All candidates are required to sit for the examination at St Peters Lutheran College Indooroopilly.

Exam date: Saturday 14 February 2026

Results: It is anticipated Academic Scholarship recipients will be advised of a successful scholarship offer by the end of Term 1 2026.

Please note the College does not disclose testing results and the results of testing remain the property of the College.
