### Learning in Boarding

Boarding gives students the advantage of time, structure and personalised academic support. Our study program is designed to build confidence, strong habits and academic independence:

- **Supervised study sessions** run Monday–Friday and on Sunday afternoons.
- **Tutoring support** is available for one-on-one help.
- **Classroom teachers** are accessible during study hours to provide guidance and clarification.

Students live and learn in a co-educational environment that encourages independence while enjoying separate, modern living spaces. Boarding fosters resilience, leadership and self-discipline — qualities that stay with students for life.



### Beyond the Classroom

Boarders enjoy full access to the College's extensive co-curricular program, including Sport, Music, Drama, the Duke of Edinburgh's Award program, Robotics and eSports, cultural activities and more.
