Please note: St Peters reserves the right to cancel any class due to insufficient numbers. In this instance all monies will be refunded. Classes are filled on a first come basis, if a class is over-subscribed parents will be given the option of remaining on a wait list or may receive a full refund of any monies paid. If classes are cancelled due to teacher illness or other unforeseen event all attempts will be made to reschedule. The program

St Peters Lutheran College offers a Pre-Prep Music Program for children aged between 3-5 years old. Children and their parents/caregivers participate together in music classes that are designed to assist children in not only developing their music skills but also their motor skills, memory, social skills and confidence.

The program is a Kodály based, pre-instrumental program. The focus is on the development of beat, rhythm and pitch through singing, moving to music, playing games and listening to music.

Small classes of up to 10 students run eight weeks a term for 30 minutes per lesson. Lessons are held in the Lower Primary Music room.

The program is open to all children and parents in the community not just those enrolled to attend St Peters. For those who are planning on attending St Peters in Preparatory, there is an added advantage of meeting other children that will be in the same cohort and also the Prep and Year 1 Music teacher. Historically this has greatly assisted children settling into Prep.

Fees

The fees for this program are \$85/term for each child, and are payable in advance. Initial places in the program will require payment upon application. Parents wishing to continue in the program will need to confirm enrolment each term and payment is required by the last lesson of the current term.

If fees are not paid by the due date, the child's place in this program may be offered to another student on the waiting list.

Refunds

Once fees have been paid for a term and you have commenced lessons for the term, your commitment to that term is expected.

No refund will be given for a child's inability to attend a lesson, unless a child is unable to attend lessons for more than one week due to an ongoing medical reason. In this case, if parents supply a copy of a supporting medical certificate, lesson costs will be credited to the following term's account.

Cancellation of lessons

- By St Peters: Wherever possible, lessons will continue as scheduled. Alternative qualified teachers may be used to ensure a lesson is not missed. In the unlikely case of a lesson being cancelled by St Peters, every effort will be made to contact the parents prior to the lesson, and the lesson will be rescheduled for the end of the term. Where this is not possible, a credit for the lesson will be applied to the following term's account.
- By parents: Where a parent wishes not to continue with the program the following term, the music teacher should be notified as soon as possible so that the place may be offered to the next student on the waiting list.

Parking

Due to the amount of vehicle and pedestrian traffic on school grounds during school hours, parents participating in the Pre-Prep Music Program must park outside of school grounds.

Visitor identification

All visitors to St Peters Lutheran College are required to sign in as a visitor when on school grounds. Parents participating in the Pre-Prep Music Program will need to sign in at the class each week.

Term schedule

Lessons begin 21 July, 2020 (Tuesday class) or 23 July, 2020 (Thursday class).

If a lesson falls on a public holiday or is cancelled by St Peters, the lesson will be rescheduled.
