Along with offering individual therapy across the lifespan, Lilley Place is also committed to improving the wellbeing of the community. In the wake of COVID-19 a need for students to receive increased support has been identified by Sarah Johnson and/or Stephanie Wise at St Peters Lutheran College. This has led to an exciting collaboration wherein Lilley Place will provide onsite psychologists along with educational assessment services.

Please allow us to introduce Tiah Dowell who will be the lead psychologist working on-campus at St Peters. Tiah has practised in a variety of settings including community mental health services, hospitals, and schools. She also delivers workshops that teach coping and emotion regulation skills to adolescents participating in holistic sporting programs. Tiah is flexible in her approach and loves to incorporate humour and creativity in her work with clients.



Our other on-campus provisional psychologist is Heather Andronicos. Heather has worked as a Crisis Counsellor with Lifeline Australia, and is a certified Mental Health First Aid and Psychological First Aid officer. She has a background in acute mental health, domestic violence and suicide prevention and uses a variety of approaches including strengths-based and solution-focussed therapies. Heather is passionate about helping others with disability, ill-health and chronic pain to live their most meaningful lives.

Highlights of accessing services through Lilley Place

- Services offered on site at St Peters Lutheran College, Springfield
- Those with flexibility can usually be seen within two-three weeks
- Can be seen for up to 10 sessions per calendar year with a GP Mental Health Care Plan or psychiatrist referral and receive a partial Medicare rebate
- Whilst respecting confidentiality and privacy of all clients, we will seek to set up a collaborative arrangement between Lilley Place and St Peters Lutheran College

Full payment is required at the end of the session by way of a completed credit card authorisation form.
