



SCHEDULE OF FEES - 2026

It is essential for the effective operation of the College, as well as its continued efficient financial management, that fee accounts are paid on time. Accordingly, parent support in making the payment of school fees a priority is appreciated. Parents/Caregivers of students are jointly and severally liable for payment of tuition fees and any other costs associated with the student's enrolment at the College.

Textbook & Resources Levy

The annual textbook and resources levy covers hire of textbooks, electronic textbooks, English novels which remain the property of the student, and photocopying of resources as well as a photocopying allowance for each student.

Technology Levy

This levy is charged yearly, to students in Years 5 to 12. Costs covered by this levy include software and applications, infrastructure upgrades, internet costs and employment of technicians. The College provides a loan device for Year 5 and Year 6 with an additional annual fee added to the Technology Levy.

Alumnae Levy

This levy is charged yearly to every student whilst they are enrolled at St Rita's College. The contribution provides them with life membership to the St Rita's College Alumnae Association upon their graduation.

Parents and Friends Levy

Master Plan Levy

This levy is necessary to assist in the funding of capital equipment and the development of infrastructure projects for the College. The levy is applied annually and is an integral source of funds to assist in meeting the continued need for modern and effective facilities.

Note – as a compulsory charge, Master Plan Levy payments are not tax deductible. However, the College also maintains the operation of a School Building Fund for additional voluntary capital donations which are 100% tax deductible.

Sports which cost \$250 or less are paid for at the time of registration via Clipboard. All other sports fees will be advised at the time of seeking nominations, and the fees will be charged in the Term in which the sport occurs, or the season commences.

For families with a direct debit or credit card plan, your ongoing payment plan amount will automatically adjust to include the new charges. Otherwise, payment is due two (2) weeks from invoice.

School Fee Conditions

Discounts to Tuition Fee for Multiple Enrolments

For families who have two or more sisters attending the College, a family discount will apply. **The discount is applied to tuition fees only** and represents **15%** for your second daughter, **20%** for the third and **25%** for your fourth daughter. Family discounts for 2026 are represented below.

Upfront Fee Discount

The College encourages upfront payment of school fees by offering a **3%** discount on the **tuition fee** component where the parents pay the full annual school fees **prior to 1 March 2026**. The annual payment figure will be available via your login to the FACTS fee management system.

Cancellation of Enrolment

In the event you wish to withdraw your daughter from St Rita's College, a full terms notice is required in writing to the Principal no later than one week prior to the term of departure. Failure to provide this notice period may result in the College charging one term's fees in lieu of notice.

Payment Conditions

The College uses an online payment portal, FACTS. The portal enables families to establish a payment plan including Direct Debit and Credit Card payments (weekly, fortnightly, monthly, termly, bi-annually or annually), as well as Third Party payment options (payment by another person on your behalf). All tuition fees, levies and Year Level camps/retreats are billed annually.

St Rita's College provides multiple options for families to pay their account. Families are billed in January for school fees, which are due and payable within 30 days of the date of the account, unless an automatic payment plan is in place. All payment plans are required to be set up in FACTS, and if fees are not paid in full, an automatic plan will need to be established. Immersion/trip experiences (including the Year 6 Trip) are paid via the FACTS payment link provided at time of acceptance. Parents looking for alternative payment arrangements over an extended period are referred to Edstart edstart.com.au/stritas with further information available on the College website.

All periodic payment arrangements need to be established by the parent/guardian in our online payment portal, FACTS. For new families, you will receive an invitation to create your account and set up a payment arrangement. For existing FACTS account holders, your periodic payment arrangement will rollover from 2024. Should you wish to change your plan frequency and/or day, please respond to the FACTS notification which you will receive after the annual billing is complete. Annual payments will also be made in the FACTS system.
