## DETAILED CURRICULUM OUTLINE

Beginning in Year 9, Toorak College students have many opportunities to connect with NAB and begin fostering their corporate network.

As part of the Year 9 TC Connect project - where students take on business-inspired roles to produce a major event - NAB professionals visit our beautiful campus to mentor students on their progress, providing advice on people management, risk, financials, and project completion.

As part of their City Experience, Year 9 reciprocates with their own visit to NAB Docklands. During a half-day visit, the NAB team lead engaging, interactive activities encouraging students to reflect on their relationship with money and other financial considerations for their future grown-up lives.

Designed specifically for those interested in the business world, NAB welcomes Unit 1&2 Business Management students to NAB headquarters in the CBD. A career panel provides inspiration through the stories of young NAB professionals, including NAB Graduates, while a tour displays the relaxed, communal and supportive vibe of the modern corporate workplace. Connected to the senior Business Management curriculum, students work with NAB's corporate social responsibility team, designing and presenting their own ideas.

In a specially designed future-focused workshop, NAB recruitment specialists visit Toorak College as part of a Year 11 future leadership day, presenting on corporate careers and recruitment. The workshop includes development of skills for getting jobs in the corporate world, demonstrations of interview dos and don'ts, and an assessment centre simulation designed to replicate the university graduate recruitment process.

As part of our ongoing partnership, NAB and Toorak College work together to find suitable applicants for NAB's Work Experience and Summer Internship Programs. Year 10 students are invited to apply for the Work Experience program held each September, while Year 12 graduates who demonstrate success in Business-related VCE subjects, and accept a university place in a suitable degree, are invited to apply to be a part of NAB's summer internship program after one year of their university degree.
