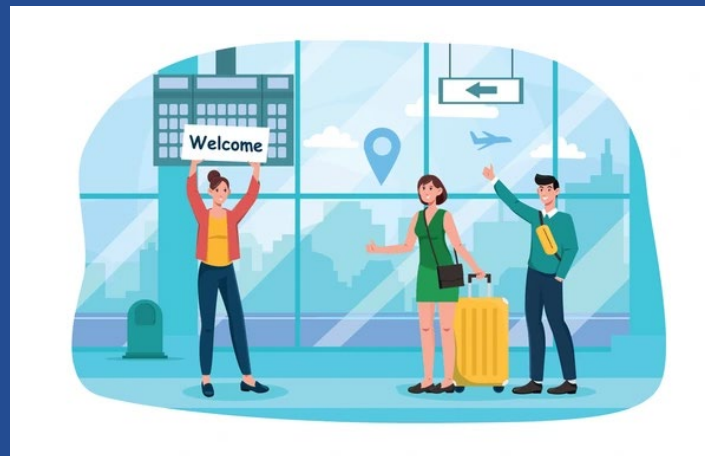

Quest Retreat: Christian Service Can Collection

- Prior to the retreat the Year 8 students will participate in a canned food collection in their neighbourhood.
- All year 8 students will receive approx. 12 doorknob flyers each.
- The students can complete the can collection, with a friend or in a group of three - we recommend doing it with another student.
- The students must decide on a **date and time window** of 1 to 2 hours before Tuesday 18th February. To complete the can collection the collection date on the space provided on the flyer.

Quest Retreat: Christian Service Can Collection

- The flyers should be distributed to homes surrounding your residence for the collection to take place several days before the chosen date of collection. **(Just your street)**
- On the dedicated day and time, revisit the homes which were distributed flyers, and collect canned goods that have been left at the letterbox etc. *The boys should not be knocking on people's doors or entering their homes. A parent must accompany the student(s) in a car close by for safety and to help carry the collected canned goods.*
- On the day of the retreat the **parent** must bring the collected canned goods and the completed form to the allocated drive-through location adjacent to the Chapel/Mann Oval.
