Dear Parents

I hope this letter finds you and your families safe and well as we near the end of the week-long lockdown. I know that you may have some questions going into your son's first day and week of school at Trinity College so please see some Year 7 specific information below;

Day One (Monday 8 February)

Year 7 students will commence the school year on Monday, 8 February. Upon arriving at school, students will make their way into the Foley Centre (old gymnasium). There will be plenty of people assisting and directing them to where they need to be! I appreciate that given it is your son's first day at school that there are many parents who would like to stay with their son once they have arrived at school. Given the new restrictions, can I please ask that you adopt a 'kiss-and-go' process as we are restricted in having adults/parents on site. Whilst I know this may cause some initial disappointment, I appreciate your understanding.

Day One Information

In order to help students and parents prepare accordingly, please read through the information below:

Uniform: Summer academic uniform. There will no longer be sports training on the first day, so students are not required to wear or bring their Physical Education uniform.

Food: Students need to bring recess and lunch (TC Canteen will be open)

Equipment: School bag with a fully charged computer, any notebooks* and pencil case.
Combination Lock must be brought to secure your son's locker!

* It is recommended that students bring some of their books in on day one and then bring the rest in on Tuesday, so their bag isn't too heavy!
