Fees Schedule for 2021:

Further to this, the College Building Fund is not included as part of the Schedule of Fees. Rather, information regarding the College Building Fund, its status as a Deductible Gift Recipient and options by which families can pledge their support, will be sent to families later in the year.

In terms of Fee Collections, the College has looked at providing a number of options for families to consider and these are listed in your School Fee statement.
