Dear Parents

I hope this letter finds you and your families safe and well. The first day of school can often bring some anxiety for students, especially new students, and I understand that the current lockdown does not alleviate such feelings. To support Year 7 students in starting their journey at Trinity College from home, students are receiving work to complete from each of their core subject areas (English, Humanities, Mathematics, Religious Education and Science).

Work Packages

Each of the packages provided allow students the opportunity to begin their learning journeys with work that encourages independent learning without being too difficult to overwhelm students. As a College, we understand that many students may not yet have access to their device or had the opportunity to navigate through the SEQTA learning platform, hence the work packages have been created. These can be completed on an individual or a shared device, printed off and completed by hand or answers/responses can be copied into individual workbooks/paper.

We also understand that many students may find some of the packages more difficult than others, especially those students on Individual Education Plans (IEP). Therefore, we have also provided a 'Daily Checklist' for students that outlines the work they should aim to complete and the work that is extension work. Please use this document to help your son organise his day and the work to be completed. If they cannot finish the work on a particular day, this is okay and there will not be a consequence for students.

I must stress that the work packages being sent home are not to add to any anxiety students may have, they are there to help support the transition of students into the secondary school. Please also note that our Year 7 teachers are aware of the difficulties for our Year 7 students in starting the school year normally, let alone starting with a lockdown! When students return to school, be confident that they will be supported within each of their subject areas rather than being negatively impacted by incomplete work during lockdown.


Student Login Credentials

You will receive an email from our IT department hopefully by end of the week with your son's login credentials for SEQTA Coneqt. Your son can login to SEQTA from any device, it does not need to be his personal device. In logging into SEQTA, your son will be able to view his timetable, courses and complete the work labelled under 'Transition' in his daily checklist. If you have not received your credentials by the end of the week, please let me know and I will follow up the issue for you.
