Wednesday 22nd September

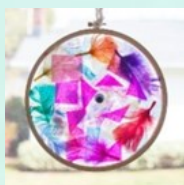
Movies and Pizza (IN)-\$2

Monday 27th September

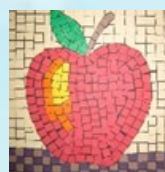
Kite Flying

Early Learning Centre September/October 2021—Vacation Care

What to bring to Vacation Care:

- Water Bottle
 - Lunch & Snacks for the day in an insulated lunch box (We are a Nut Free Centre)
 - Hat (preferably wide brimmed)
 - Sun safe clothing (covered shoulder, no singlets or strappy dresses please)
- * Vacation Care is open from 6:30am until 6:00pm each day of the School holidays. Children cannot be dropped off or signed in to the service prior to the opening hours. Please notify us as soon as possible if you think you may not arrive to collect your child by 6:30pm. An initial late fee of \$20 will be charged as well as \$1/minute thereafter if your child is collected after this time.
- * CCS benefits are applicable only when families are eligible, have provided their correct CRN and DOB details and have confirmed their enrolment online with Centrelink.
- * Once confirmed by the service, all bookings are final. All fees associated with bookings, should the child not attend due to illness or for any other reason, will be required to be paid in full. CCS will apply in accordance with allowable and approved absence provisions (*to avoid paying these fees, a minimum of 48 hours notice is required to cancel your booking*)
- * Children and families are required to abide by all items in the TMC Early Learning Centre Policies & Procedures Manual. Please contact the ELC Service Director (Rachael Fernandez) should you wish to view this document.
