# 2021 Fee Schedule

There are two (2) terms per semester, and two (2) semesters per year.

\*Year 12 Tuition and Boarding Fees are invoiced over three terms (Term 1, 2 and 3).

The Boarding Fee is additional to the Tuition Fee for the year(s) enrolled. The Boarding Fee includes all meals, laundry and mending. Students need to supply their own bed linen, blankets, pillows and towels.

## Miscellaneous fees

### Sundry Expenses Levy

Prep – Year 12: **\$86** per semester / **\$172** per year

This levy covers items such as Student Insurance, School Diary, most local excursions, School Magazine, class reference books, academic competitions, sports buses (Primary School) and student ID cards (Secondary School).

### Capital Maintenance Levy

Prep - Year 12: **\$172** per semester / **\$344** per year

### Technology Levy

Prep - Year 6: **\$138** per semester / **\$276** per year

Years 7 - 12: **\$230** per semester / **\$460** per year

This levy is to assist the School with the cost of technology across the whole school.

### Class Set Levy

Years 7 - 12: **\$36** per semester / **\$72** per year

This levy covers replacement and purchase of class set books in English and other subjects where books are used for short periods of time. Students will still need to purchase the main textbook for most subjects.

## Special (optional) subject fees

### Music

General music studies are offered as part of the School's curriculum. Private instrumental, theory or voice tuition is also available through the School at an additional cost.

#### Extra Music Tuition: Individual\*\*

Prep - Year 4 (30 min lesson) **\$374/term\***; **\$1,496/year**

Years 5 - 12 (40 min lesson) **\$475/term\***; **\$1,900/year**

#### Extra Music Tuition: Pairs\*\*

Years 5 - 12 **\$285/term\***; **\$1,140/year**

Beginner lessons are offered to students who are available to be grouped in like instruments. Lessons will be offered only for two students each lesson. Rescheduling of, or credit for, missed lessons is not possible for beginner lessons.

\*\* Eight (8) lessons per term.

## Remedial/Learning Support

A Learning Support programme for English and Mathematics is offered through the Secondary School at the RGS Learning Enrichment Centre.

1 x 40 minute lesson per week **\$368** per term

2 x 40 minute lessons per week **\$736** per term

Programmes are also available for RGS Primary School students. A nominal fee is charged for these programmes depending on the additional support required.

## Enrolment fees

### Application Fee: \$60 per student

To be submitted with application form.

This fee is non-refundable.

### Confirmation Fee: \$400 per student

Payment of this fee confirms a student's place at the School after a position has been offered.

This fee is non-refundable.

*Interest is not charged on application and confirmation fees.*



# Terms and Conditions

## Payment

Fees are paid by term, in advance.

Fees are due and payable by the following dates:

- **Term 1** 11 February 2021
- **Term 2** 4 May 2021
- **Term 3** 27 July 2021
- **Term 4** 19 October 2021

**If fees are outstanding after the due date, an administration charge of \$200 will be incurred. Students will not be allowed to commence a new term unless a reason for non-payment has been given in writing and an arrangement is in place to pay the fees and accepted by the Board Secretary.**

Participation in excursions, sporting tours, ski trips and similar activities is not allowed if fees are overdue unless specific approval is granted by the Headmaster.

**Outstanding fees constitute a debt to the Board of Trustees of the School.** Overdue fees may be placed in the hands of a collection agency. If necessary, the Trustees may take legal action to recover the debt to preserve the financial viability of the School.

Upon leaving the School, accounts with a credit balance of \$20 or less will be assumed as a donation to the School, and will not be refunded. Donations of credit balances of more than \$20 will be gratefully received. Please contact the Accounts Department if you wish to make a donation.

**Payment Plans:** Edstart ([www.edstart.com.au](http://www.edstart.com.au)) is a specialist provider that offers customised funding packages for independent school fees. Edstart allows parents to spread out their school fee costs beyond the period of tuition, lowering their monthly repayments.

## Withdrawal

Parents wishing to withdraw their child(ren) from the School and/or the Boarding House must inform the Headmaster in writing ([headmaster@rgs.qld.edu.au](mailto:headmaster@rgs.qld.edu.au)), **giving one term's notice**. Fees will be charged for one half-term in lieu of required notice. One half term is deemed to be not less than five weeks.

For students not returning to RGS in 2022, written notice is required by the end of Term 3, otherwise one half term's fees will be payable for the following year.

## Absences during term

No allowances against fees will be made for late returns to School or absence during the term - including those due to disciplinary suspensions, or for the early completion of Year 12.

## Monthly accounts

The School issues monthly statements. Parents should exercise judgement in whether small amounts, for example less than \$20, are paid on receipt of statement or left until the following month and accumulated with larger amounts.

Outstanding charges must be paid by the due date indicated on the invoice.

Payments are receipted to accounts on the date of their receipt by the School and are applied to the oldest charges on the account at that time.

## Cancellation of enrolment

The School reserves the right to cancel a student's enrolment for non-payment of school fees.

Enrolment will be cancelled at the end of a term if fees for that term or prior terms have not been paid, unless an approved payment arrangement has been made.
