Introduction

The Qur'an is the most important source of guidance in a Muslim's life. Helping children build strong Qur'an literacy at home is one of the greatest investments a parent can make — one that benefits both you and your child in this life and the Hereafter.

The Prophet ﷺ said:

خَيْرُكُمْ مَنْ تَعَلَّمَ الْقُرْآنَ وَعَلَّمَهُ

“The best of you are those who learn the Qur'an and teach it.”

[Sahih al-Bukhari]



This booklet gives parents practical steps to support accurate recitation (tajweed), consistent memorisation (hifdh), and a loving relationship with the Qur'an that lasts a lifetime.

Understanding Qur'an Literacy

Qur'an literacy is more than fluent reading.

It includes:

1. Tajweed —

Correct articulation of each letter and applying the rules of recitation.

2. Fluent Recitation —

Smooth pacing with proper elongations (madd) and pauses (waqf).

3. Memorisation (Hifdh) —

Committing verses to memory while preserving accuracy.

4. Comprehension —

Understanding meanings so guidance can be lived daily.

When these four are nurtured together, children develop confidence, respect, and love for the Book of Allah.

Your Role as a Parent



Model Recitation

Let your child see and hear you reading the Qur'an daily.



Show Value

Speak positively about the Qur'an and honour those who recite it.



Create Structure

Set a consistent daily time for Qur'an practice.



Guide Gently

Listen regularly, correct with kindness, and celebrate effort.

Children mirror the love and respect you show.

Setting Up for Qur'an Success at Home



Dedicated Space

A quiet, clean, distraction-free area for reading.



Personal Mushaf

Each child should have their own Qur'an copy.



Audio Support

Use clear, reliable recitations for modelling.

Consistency

10-15 minutes every day beats long, irregular sessions.

Supporting Qur'an Recitation

The 3-Step Cycle

1

Listen & Repeat

Hear the ayah multiple times, then repeat aloud.

2

Read & Repeat

Read from the mushaf until fluent and stable.

3

Close & Recall

Recite from memory; then check and correct.

Here's a tip!

Encourage reciting newly memorised ayaat in Salah.

Support Steady Qur'an Progress

✗ Rush memorisation

✓ Take time to focus on accuracy before moving forward.

✗ Skip revision

✓ Revise daily so memorisation stays strong.

✗ Correct harshly

✓ Give gentle corrections to build confidence and love for Qur'an.

✗ Leave it solely to the teacher

✓ Stay involved at home; your encouragement is key.

Memorising the Qur'an is not just about how much we know by heart — it is about building a deep connection with Allah's words.

Each verse we learn is a step closer to Him, shaping our hearts, guiding our actions, and elevating us in this life and the next.
