Little Farmers – Big Adventures

This is an exciting opportunity for our Prep students to explore the world of farming through curiosity, creativity, and care. Students will connect with the Senior School Agriculture Program and experience life on the farm. Throughout Term 2, all classes will take part in a blend of classroom learning and some visits to the farm, bringing learning to life in a meaningful, hands-on way.

Children will explore the world of dairy farming, gaining an understanding of where food comes from, and how farms operate. There will also be special opportunities to observe and learn alongside older students during practical lessons, helping to build connections across the school.

This experience is thoughtfully linked to the Australian Curriculum across Science, Technologies and Health and encourages curiosity, responsibility, and real-world learning.
